Dear Tim,

Thank you for your faxes, both of which were received.

Thank you, too, for your splendid efforts with the CJA. It is wonderful that they should wish to be involved in monitoring the process here and helping to fund it. We are having a meeting on Monday at which this will be discussed and we will then come back to you.

Did the CJA have any ideas how they would like us to proceed -- ie for us to put forward a proposal to them and for them to respond or for them to suggest how they would be prepared to go about such a project or what aid and resource they could bring to bear on the project?

Our thinking as we discussed ranges over setting up a team to spend a fairly lengthy period here monitoring both the broadcast and print media and having that team refreshed by new people after a certain period of time.

We are coming around to the thought that because of the numerous languages and services used here, such a team may need a local infrastructure. This would be responsible for monitoring groundwork, such as providing basic material on the quality and quantity of news and other informative broadcasts and print stories in an understandable form to the monitors who could then hone in on specific media presentations with the assistance of translators, etc.

Our meeting is on Monday December 2, and I would be most appreciative of any further thoughts you may have for me to present at that meeting. Have you any thoughts on your own possible involvement?
